CERTIFICATION REGARDING PURCHASING COOPERATIVE FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICTS WITH AVERAGE DAILY ATTENDANCE OF LESS THAN 2,500

Effective: July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026

This Certification is issued in accordance with Education Code section 38112 and Fresno County Superintendent of Schools (FCSS) Administrative Regulation 3300 (Purchase of Standard School Supplies and Equipment) and is effective during the period stated above.
